A pioneering development, ANM led the way in providing a purpose-built auction centre that has and continues to serve us well.




Our vision for the future at Thainstone will maintain the reputation of the auction ring as the best possible place to do business, while retaining its role as the natural meeting point for the northeast community.

Our improvements in sustainable operations, with enhanced water and effluent management, energy from waste and renewable power generation could all establish a new standard for our industry.







RETAIN AS IS REFURBISH REBUILD

To scrap a whole mart which is only 30 years old and build a new one a few metres away is unbelievable. To build a new mart in the current circumstances is a crazy idea, I am definitely against building a new mart...

If you have to, I'd upgrade what we have at Thainstone – it's in a very favourable position on the flat, just off the main road, and very easy to get cattle in and out of.

The current site definitely requires work and it's my belief that the current Thainstone building is no longer fit for purpose and the site itself could be much modernised and more efficient.

If farming is to move forward, and I believe the entire industry is at a crossroads, then a new facility can capitalise on the opportunities which exist, allowing ANM and farming in the north east as a whole, to progress.

'...is in full support of ANM looking into the possibility of a new mart development. He thought it was very forward looking on their part and given that change is happening throughout the industry then it is only right that ANM look to evolve. There is no reason to think that we cannot recreate the excellent facilities that currently exist in a better and more efficient form.'

I don't think that a complete replacement will be a viable proposal.

It needs investment in the existing facility with dwindling livestock numbers to encourage an increase in stock in the area to then keep the place going. The alternative uses for industry / slaughter house etc can still be built without the complete new auction centre.

Without investment and change to the current site, both ANM and farming in the region will see themselves less well placed to take advantage of the future and find themselves in a weakened position.
